Forms of Payment

We accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, Discover, company checks, and cash. New customers may choose to apply for a terms account with Montale Gardens, however, all orders are C.O.D. until such terms are approved. Established accounts must be maintained in good standing. Terms are NET 30 days. Full payment is due within 30 days of the invoice date. If paying by check, a \$35 fee will be charges for any return/bounced payments.

Accounts over 90 days delinquent will no longer be entitled to terms and will be turned back in to a C.O.D. account.
