Paris                Silvered green (Continuous rose flowers)

**PURPLE LEAVES**

Midnight Rose      Black leaves with splashes of rose

Molly Bush         Dark bronzy-purple (Sun tolerant)

Obsidian            Shiny, almost black

Palace Purple       Bronzy-purple (Sun tolerant)

Plum Pudding       Silvered plum with darker veins

## ***quercifolia* variety**

(Oakleaf Hydrangea)

Can thrive in dryer locations than its cousins

Does not like “wet feet”

Needs little maintenance

Blooms on old wood - prune immediately after flowering



Blooms in Summer

## ***arborescens* varieties**

(Smooth hydrangea)

Average soil

Flowers are great for winter interest

Prune back to 12” in spring.



Blooms in Summer

Blooms best in full sun to partial shade

## ***macrophylla and serrata* varieties**

(mophead, bigleaf hydrangea, lacecap hydrangea)

Moist soils

Avoid late afternoon sun.

Stems often die to the ground in winter,  
but all our varieties bloom on new growth.

Prune in spring.



Mid-day sun for best blooming.

## *paniculata* varieties

(panicle hydrangea)

Large, cone-shaped flower clusters from summer through fall.

Full sun to partial shade

Average moisture

Blooms on new wood—prune to shape in early spring
